Aim of the course The aim of the course is to familiarize students with the basic types of banking and non-banking financial institutions as well as with the basic principles of banking operations. The course provides students with knowledge on most important active, passive, own and neutral banking operations (short-term and long-term). Finally, students learn about financial innovations and modern tendencies in banking operations.			
Course outcomes After successfully completing the course, students will be able to explain the role of different types of banks and their position in both national and international financial system; understand basic principles in banking operations; perform a credit analysis; assess and perform a selection of investment projects as well as demonstrate an understanding of most important banking activities.			
Content of the course <i>Theoretical lectures</i> Introduction to banking; conceptual aspects of banking, emission (central bank) and its functions, types of banks (commercial, investment, universal...), principles of banking operations, bank activities (active, passive, own and neutral), short-term credit-financing of commercial sector, long-term credit-financing of commercial sector, population credit-financing, financial innovations, e-money, e-banking. <i>Practical course work</i> Institutional aspects of banking, methods and instruments of realization of central bank's functions, other classifications of banks, non-banking financial institutions, principles of banking operations, bank activities (active, passive, own and neutral), credit analysis, types of short-term loans for commercial sector, banking system of the Republic of Serbia, electronic banking in Serbia.
