Aim of the course The aim of the course is to familiarize students with the most important financial markets and financial exchanges, participants in stock exchange operations, most important stock exchange operations and technology on financial markets, with an overview of the application of information and communication technologies in stock exchange operations and stock market automation.			
Course outcomes After successfully completing the course, students will be familiar with the most important financial markets and instruments of financial markets, financial stock exchanges, technology of work on financial stock exchanges and broker-dealer societies. Students will demonstrate an understanding of the most important stock exchange activities and the role of participants in stock exchange operations.			
Content of the course <i>Theoretical lectures</i> The notion of and characteristics of stock exchanges, formation and development of stock exchanges, types of stock exchanges, financial stock exchanges, information and communication technologies in stock exchange business and stock market automation, stock market creation and activity, stock exchange organization, stock exchange traders, brokerage brokers, broker-dealer companies, stock exchange operations, stock exchange trading technology, exchange rate and stock market listing, stock exchange speculation, off-exchange market, central registry, clearing and settlement, stock exchange control, investor protection in financial exchanges. <i>Practical course work</i> The most important financial stock exchanges, reading of stock exchange reports, stock exchange material, conditions for registration of stock exchange, spot stock exchange transactions, termination of business operations, stock exchange cycle, stock exchange crises, money market and foreign exchange market, bond market, mortgage market, stock market, forward market and futures, market options and swaps.
