Aim of the course			
The aim of the course is to familiarize students with the institutional domestic and international regulations of this field, as well as practical work and activities of customs and freight forwarding. This way, students are trained to perform key jobs in foreign trade in goods and services, that is, in international freight traffic.

After successfully completing the course, students will be able to: perform all types of activities in international trade; to apply theoretical knowledge and practical experience for involving economic entities in international trade, to focus participants' activity in import-export activities into achieving economic-financial efficiency and effectiveness and demonstrate knowledge of domestic regulations and documentation flow in international transport and freight forwarding.			
Content of the course			
<i>Theoretical lectures</i>			
Functioning of foreign trade, conditions for implementation and control of foreign trade, the most important activities in foreign trade, international transport and insurance of goods, general customs terms and conditions, concept, importance and types of customs, organization of customs service, implementation of customs procedures in all modes of transport, implementation customs procedure with goods in transport and goods of natural persons, storage of customs goods, free trade zones and customs sales facilities, general terms and regulations on freight forwarding, organization of freight forwarding industry, freight forwarding document and sequence of individual tasks in international freight.			
<i>Practical course work</i>			
Foreign trade, forms of foreign trade, types of international transport and implementation of goods insurance in transport, development and functioning of the customs system, customs, customs tariff and customs value of goods, customs control and customs instruments, excise taxation and single customs documents, organization of customs services in Serbia, concept, characteristics and functions of international freight forwarding, international freight forwarding system, responsibility of international freight forwarder and freight forwarding documentation.
