<b>Aim of the course</b> The aim of the course is to familiarize the students with law institutions and economic-legal notions, especially with the status and form of organizing in economy and economic-legal contracts. Students will develop the skills necessary to perform basic legal actions.			
<b>Outcome of the course</b> After successfully completing the course, the students will have acquired knowledge on basic legal forms in economy and will have learned to make the most important types of economic-legal contract.			
<b>Content of the course</b> <i>Theoretical lectures</i> Theory of formation of law and state; The notion of law and state; Legal norm; Sources of law; Law interpretation; The notion of civil law; Subjective and objective law; Property law; The notion of property; Ownership and possession; Law of obligation; Sources of obligations and types of contracts; The notion of Trade law and its subject; Relation with other branches of law; Trade law regulations and the basis of law; The notion and types of companies; The notion of dividend and shareholders' rights; Statutory changes with companies; liquidation and bankruptcy; Public companies, banks and trade unions; The notion of a commercial contract and securities; Types – particular economic and legal contract; Practical examples and formulation of a economic-legal contract. <i>Practical course work</i> Passing of laws and other legal (general) legal acts - Official Gazette of RS, municipal newsletters, bulletin board; Social and legal norm - practical examples; Social and legal norm - dispositions and sanctions; The Constitution as the source of law - concept, description and content of the new Constitution; The laws of importance to commercial law - the Law on Companies; Important laws for trade law - the Law of Obligations; Important laws for trade law - the Law on Basic Property Relations; Hexagon of natural rights; Making of an economic contract.
